


Place regular Jib Weights in Weight Bucket and Round Weights on Support Shaft as needed to balance Jib



- The Riser Nut should be loose from step -A-, the Fluid Head, the Camera, and all its accessories are in place.
- Add additional Weights to the tail of the Crossarm. By rocking the Crossarm you will be able to Judge when balance has been achieved.
- G Tighten Riser Nut. A block of wood and a hammer works well. NEVER HIT RISER NUT DIRECTLY WITH HAMMER-
- Place Retaining Collar on tail of Crossarm, continue to fill the Weight Bucket until balance of Jib is achieved.
  Place Retaining Collar on both sides of the Weight Bucket.
